Pedestrian Protection

- ↗ Permits
- ↗ Certifications
- ↗ Enforcement



DC Permitting Requirements

- ↗ Public Space Permit
- ↗ Covered Walkways
- ↗ Propane
- ↗ Hot Work
- ↗ Operator's License
- ↗ Tower Crane



Public Space Permit

- ↗ Why you need it
 - Any time we are in public area
- ↗ How you get it
 - 941 North Capital
 - www.dkra.dc.org
- ↗ Special Requirements
 - Approved traffic control plan



Covered Walkways

- ↗ Why you need it
 - Within 15' of work zone
- ↗ How you get it
 - Part of Public Space
- ↗ Special Requirements
 - Submit design
 - Lighting plan
 - Master Electrician Signature



Propane

- ↗ Why you need it
 - Temp heating
- ↗ How you get it
 - DC Fire Marshall
- ↗ Special Requirements
 - Pulled by contractor providing heat
 - Plan showing area, amount, signage, extinguishers



Hot Work

- ↗ Why you need it
 - Welding, burning, grinding, etc.
- ↗ How you get it
 - DC Fire Marshal
- ↗ Special Requirements
 - Held by subcontractor doing work
 - GC as backup



Operator's License

- ↗ Why you need it
 - Equipment over 25hp
- ↗ How you get it
 - DCRA & Pearson VUE
 - 877-543-5217
 - Details on ARROW
 - Lengthy Process
 - Fee and Exam
- ↗ Special Requirements
 - Exam in English only



Tower Crane

- ↗ Why you need it
- ↗ How you get it
 - DCRA
- ↗ Special Requirements
 - Typically pulled by Sub
 - Copy of Building Permit, Swing area drawing, Duration, Varying fee



MD Permitting Requirements

- ↗ Cranes
- ↗ Rigging
- ↗ “Green Card”
- ↗ Life Safety Code



Cranes

- ↗ Local Requirements
 - MOSH
 - Certified Operator
 - Notification to MOSH for Assembly and Disassembly
- ↗ How to comply
 - NCCCO, Crane Institute
 - Company Equivalent Program
 - Copy of certification/training



Rigging

↗ Local Requirements

- MOSH
- Level 1, Level 2, Master Rigger

↗ How to comply

- NCCCO, Crane Institute
- Company Equivalent Program
- Contractor – evaluate performance



Erosion & Sediment Control Certification

↗ Local Requirements

- “The Green Card”
- Must have certified person on site when soil is disturbed

↗ How to comply

- Pass examination
- Study materials and exam schedule online



Life Safety Code

- ↗ Local Requirements
 - City Gaithersburg
 - Comply with all of Life Safety Code
 - Requires STAIRS from deck to deck
- ↗ How to comply
 - Pour stairs as you go
 - Temp Stair Tower



VA Permitting Requirements

- ↗ Equipment Spotters
- ↗ Traffic Control Manager
- ↗ Responsible Land Disturber
- ↗ VDOT ESCCC
- ↗ Propane
- ↗ Crane Banners



Equipment Spotters

- ↗ Local Requirements
 - VOSH
 - Spotter for backing equipment with blind spot
- ↗ How to comply
 - Trained (documented) spotter
 - VOSH Website
 - http://www.doli.virginia.gov/vosh_enforcement/reverse_signal.html



Work Zone Traffic Control Certification

- ↗ Local Requirements
 - Must have “Basic Level” person on site (can be sub)
- ↗ How to comply
 - Check with subcontractor
 - VDOT
 - Private Instructors
- ↗ Keep record once completed



Erosion & Sediment Control Responsible Land Disturber

- Local Requirements
 - VA Dept of Conservation & Recreation
 - Must have certified person on site
- How to comply
 - Study materials and test online
 - http://www.dcr.virginia.gov/soil_and_water/es_rld.shtml
 - \$115 Fee
 - Good for three years
- Notify CKC when completed



VDOT Erosion and Sediment Control Contractor Cert

- Local Requirements
 - Must have certified person on site
 - In VDOT right of way
 - 10,000 + square feet disturbed
- How to comply
 - Classes and exam offered twice per year
 - www.vtca.org for dates
 - \$185 fee (job chargeable)
- Keep record when completed



Propane

↗ Local Requirements

- Arlington County
- All on site storage

↗ How to comply

- Pulled by contractor storing propane



Crane Banners

↗ Local Requirements

- Arlington County
- Can not fly banners from Tower Cranes....UNLESS

↗ How to comply

- Include use of banner as part of Tower Crane set up submittal
- Additional Fee
