Judging Criteria

1. This form must be completed in its entirety. Incomplete submissions will not be accepted.
2. Self-nominations are accepted.
3. Nominators may nominate as many candidates as they would like.
4. This form must be received (not post marked) by April 30th.
5. The nominee must be a member of WMACSA in the past year.
6. The time period describe is the nominee's work in the past **3 years only!**
7. Each criteria has a point value assigned to it and will be scored accordingly.
8. The decision of the selection committee will be final.
9. Nominees cannot be on the selection committee.
10. There will be a board member liaison for the committee. This does NOT exclude them from being nominated.
11. The award will be presented at the June meeting. Membership and free meeting attendance will be included for the following year.
